The program focuses on cultivating tomorrow's talents with a global perspective, by equipping them with cross-cultural competence and communication skills, providing them with a multi-cultural and multi-language learning environment, helping them better understand and adapt to cross-cultural challenges, so that they can succeed in a variety of global business environments in their careers.
2. Provides systemic and practice-oriented learning experience by integrating global theories with local practices
The program features a comprehensive field of business studies by taking advantage of the many academic and non-academic resources of the whole university and the faculties of economics, management, tourism and foreign languages. Emphasis is placed on sharpening students' professional knowledge, practical awareness and competitive advantages in their chosen industry and career.

- Modern Industrial System explores how cities build a high-quality and efficient modern service industry system, advance in-depth integration of urban modern service industry with advanced manufacturing industry, accelerate the development of the digital economy, and create an urban digital industry cluster of international competitiveness.
- Chinese Civilization and Urban Culture explores the modernization of Chinese culture and civilization, the exchange and mutual understanding between Chinese and Western civilizations, and Chinese urban culture.
- Construction of Urban Ecological Civilization explores how to promote sustainable urban development around the connotation, requirements, modes and paths of ecological civilization, accelerate the development of ecologically friendly cities, advocate eco-tourism, implement rural revitalization and coordination with urban development, and build an ecologically civilized city of international competitiveness.
- International Affairs Research explores the key contents of political parties and international organizations, cultural diplomacy, and foreign-related legal affairs.

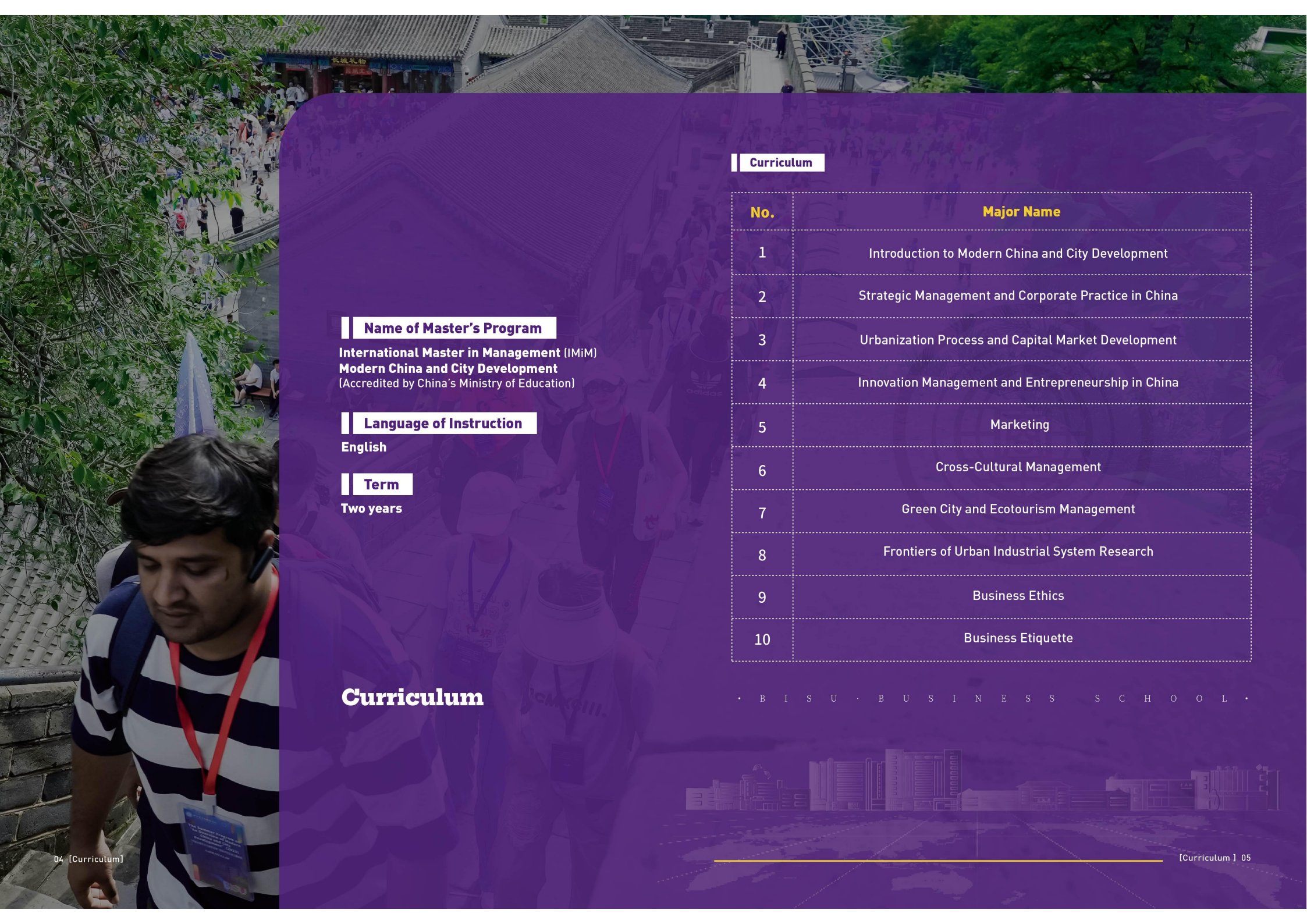

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Requirements

Application Requirements

Applicants between the ages of 18 and 50 with good health and a bachelor's degree or above.

Application Materials

BISU International Student Application Form, a photocopy of passport or residence permit, resume, statement of purpose, university diploma and bachelor's degree certificate (undergraduates should provide proof of school attendance, and the original copy should be submitted for verification when registering), undergraduate and graduate, if any, transcripts, a letter of recommendation from one professor, 2 recent photos and.

Language Requirements

Applicants should have a minimum score of TOEFL (PBT) 550, TOEFL (iBT) 80, or IELTS 6.0. Applicants from English-speaking countries or whose degree program is taught in English are exempt from the English language proficiency proof. Applicants from BISU partner universities can be exempt from the English language proficiency proof by providing an English proficiency certificate of B2 level or above from their home universities.

Application

1 Application Procedures

- ① BISU adopts an online application procedure. Applicants can register and log into the BISU International Student Service System (<http://apply.bisu.edu.cn/>) for application.
- ② Time for Online Application: December 25, 2023 to June 30, 2024. The application language is Chinese or English.
- ③ Applicants must provide genuine, accurate, complete and valid information in the system. Applicants will be responsible for all adverse consequences arising from incorrect, omitted, false or invalid information they provide.
- ④ Applicants shall also upload additional materials as required in the system. The attachments should be color-scanned copies, and the originals should be reserved for verification. If the application materials are not in Chinese or English, a Chinese or English translation must be attached.

2 Review

BISU will review the application materials, organize entrance examinations or interviews, and admit the best candidates according to the evaluation results. During the period of review, applicants can log in BISU International Student Service System for application updates, progress and relevant notices. It usually takes 15 working days to review the materials.

3 Admission

After making admission decisions, BISU will send the Visa Application Form for Study in China (JW202/JW201) and the Admission Notice of BISU before July 31. Applicants shall apply for an "X1" visa at the Chinese Embassy/Consulate abroad with the Visa Application Form, Admission Notice and Health Examination Report.

4 Registration

New students shall register within the time specified in the Admission Notice. Those who fail to register within the time limit without providing proper reasons will be considered dropouts automatically. Before registering, new students should contact the university to apply for the specific arrival time, and confirm the arrival date and relevant requirements with the school. When registering at the university, please bring the Admission Notice, the Visa Application Form for Study in China (JW201/202 form), the original application materials and five 2-inch white background ID photos. If you have had a physical examination at your home country, please also bring all the original physical examination records.

5 Verification

BISU will verify new students' admission eligibility upon and after the registration. If any inconsistency in the materials is detected, or there are fraud, malpractice and other illegal circumstances, the student will be determined as unqualified, and his/her admission and student status will be revoked.

6 Health Examination

According to China's regulations, international students who plan to study in China for over half a year need to submit a standard health examination form (available at the Chinese Embassy/Consulate abroad), and the university needs to submit the forms to a designated hospital for verification. Students need to pay 60 RMB as fees. Those who fail to pass need to redo all examinations at designated hospitals at their own costs. International students who do not have health examination in their own countries will be organized by BISU to go to a designated hospital for examination after arrival, and the cost (about 400 RMB) will be borne by the students.

7 Insurance

According to China's regulations, international students must have medical insurance coverage during their stay in China. New students are required to buy Accident Insurance and Hospitalization Insurance when registering for admission. The insurance premium is about 800 RMB per person for a year.

8 Charge Standards

(1) Tuition fee
Application fee: 800 RMB
Tuition fee: 30,000 RMB/academic year (Outstanding applications are eligible for various levels of financial aid)
(2) Accommodation fees and facilities

- Note:
- ① Apartment No.2 has a public kitchen, public bathroom and a public washroom (with washing machines and dryers);
 - ② Apartment room deposit is 500 RMB/person. If the equipment in the room is not damaged when the student checks out, the room deposit will be returned;
 - ③ This apartment information table is tentative, and room allocation will be arranged by BISU during registration;
 - ④ 100 kilowatt-hours will be free of charge for each room every month to cover daily usage, and students need to pay any extra charges;
 - ⑤ If you pay the accommodation fee in advance, you can have discounts on the accommodation fee for the winter and summer vacations. The specific policy is subject to the regulations of the International Student Apartment Management Center.

Note:

- ① Unless in special circumstances, those who fail to pay tuition and accommodation fees within ten days after registration must pay an additional 5% overdue fine.
- ② Please take into consideration the impact of daily exchange rate changes, international bank transfer charges and other factors on the final amount of actual tuition paid, as well as notice that the payment of tuition and fees must be in RMB.
- ③ When new students enter the university, the university can handle residence application procedures for them on their behalf, and the agency fees and visa fees shall be borne by the students.
- ④ Neither the application fee nor the tuition and accommodation fee is refundable.
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10 Scholarship

(1) CHINESE GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP

China's Ministry of Education entrusts the Chinese Scholarship Fund Management Committee to be responsible for the enrollment and management of the Chinese Government Scholarship. The scholarship is divided into full scholarship and partial scholarship. The full scholarship will subsidize tuition, accommodation fees, living expenses, and comprehensive medical insurance premiums, while the partial scholarship only subsidizes one or more of them. The students should contact the Chinese Embassy/Consulate abroad to apply for the scholarships.

The contact information of the Chinese Embassy/Consulate abroad can be found on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of China (<https://www.fmprc.gov.cn/>).

BISU is a recipient of the Chinese Government Scholarship, the school code is 10031.

(2) BEIJING GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP

The Beijing Government Scholarship is a tuition scholarship sponsored by the Beijing Municipal Government for outstanding foreign students studying in Beijing. Students applying for this program can apply for the Beijing Government New Student Scholarship, which will reduce or waive the tuition fee for the first academic year upon approval. Please refer to the website (<http://admission.bisu.edu.cn/col/col117986/index.html>) for the scholarship application method. International students who are already enjoying the Chinese Government Scholarship are excluded from the evaluation.

(3) BISU SCHOLARSHIP

In order to attract outstanding international students to study at BISU, improve the education quality of international students, and enhance the international influence of our university, Beijing International Studies University has set up the "BISU Scholarship". BISU Scholarship is mainly used to pay for the accommodation fees of international students.

Students applying for this program can apply for the BISU Scholarship, which will reduce or waive the first semester's accommodation fee upon approval. International students who are already enjoying the Chinese Government Scholarship are excluded from the evaluation.

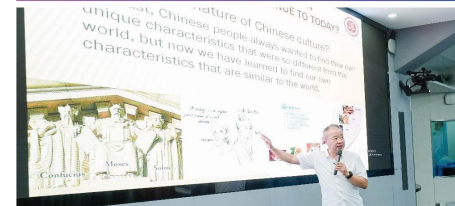

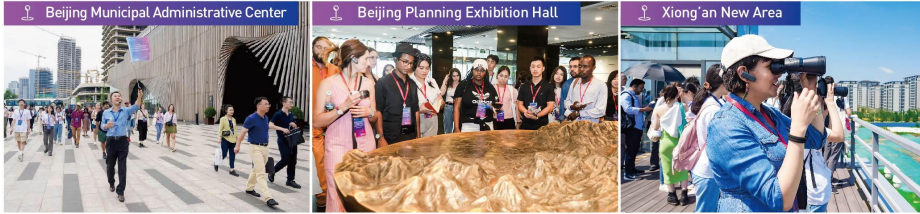
