Chinese language advanced I

Credit: 2

Brief introduction:

This course aims at intermediate level of Chinese learners. This course aims to improve students' basic language skills through systematic, sustained, and all-around training of listening, reading, speaking, writing, and translating skills via the reading of texts and discussions in class, assignments after class, and the additional materials and exercises. Students will be introduced to new language phenomena, will become more aware of socio-cultural issues in the learning of language, and will learn to appreciate Chinese language from a new perspective.

This course is suitable for students who already have a certain level of Chinese (roughly equivalent to HSK3). Students are required to have nearly 600 words, Chinese characters and have a basic grammatical framework for Chinese.
